Winter Festivals and Celebrations

PHSE

To be able to discuss safety at Bonfire Nights. Holding sparklers etc. Remembrance Service, Discussion of why we wear poppies. Thinking of others. Friendships and team work. Discuss advent as the time approaches Christmas. Talk about the gifts we would like to receive and give at Christmas. How did Mary and Joseph feel on their long journey to Bethlehem?

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

(Science, Geography, ICT, RE.)

Bonfire Night: Gunpowder Plot - Guy Fawkes. Use a paint/drawing program on the IWB for children to draw pictures of the characters from the story.

Remembrance Day - history WW's. Have a selection of child-friendly ICT equipment available for children to research.

Diwali - Rama and Sita story. Using a child-friendly search engine, allow the children to look for autumn images or pictures on computers or tablets.

Thanksgiving - The Mayflower and Pilgrims.

Autumn - Winter - Take the children on an autumn walk to look for seasonal changes and record observations with a digital camera. Look after the animals that don't hibernate over the winter by feeding the birds.

Journey to Bethlehem - The first Christmas, learning the nativity story and practising for the church service.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

Firework painting - create a display. Create poppies for display. Backdrops for Nativity.

Make wrapping paper, Christmas cards, calendars. Make stars from shiny paper, decorate letters to Father Christmas.
