## History:

We will investigate over 3 million years of human history during this half term! We will find out about developments in technology, art, society and so much more. We will find out what evidence there is to show how people lived.

## Science:

This term we will investigate Sound and Hearing, finding out about how sounds are produced and received.

We will also find out about how pattern can be used to make art and the way that different contemporary societies across the world convey meaning through it.

## Literacy:

## Maths:

Over the next few weeks, we have a focus on Geometry. We will investigate angles, before moving on to look at 3D shapes. We will also find out about the properties of rectangles and symmetry. We will then look at co-ordinates and plot reflection and translations of shapes.
